Varsity College High Schools Touch League - 2006 Spring Season

- **Starting Date Friday 8th September, finishing weather permitting on 27th October**
- **Enter online at www.touchrugby.co.za or www.varsitycollege.co.za**
- First weeks games will be for "Grading", thereafter 5 weeks of pool games followed by the FINAL.
- Teams will play one game per week on Friday afternoons against other school teams in their respective divisions. Games will start from 14:00.
- Teams will play in divisions of 6.

Format and Age Groups

- This is an OPEN tournament – i.e. there are no age groups. If the league is full, preference will be given to teams from form 11 and 12.
- More than 1 team per school may enter, however should the league be full, organizers reserve the right to limit this to 1 team.
- The "6 down" variation of Touch Rugby will be played. This is the international version of the sport and rules can be downloaded at www.touchrugby.co.za
- Team squads consist of up to 10 players – 6 players will be on the field at one time.
- A players name must appear on the indemnity/registration form and played a **minimum of 3 games** to be eligible to play in the Final.
- **A player may only be registered for one team**, however if he/she is needed to "help out" in another team, it would only be acceptable if he/she plays in a lower division to the team needing a player.

Cancellation and Postponement

- A team not arriving for their scheduled games will forfeit the points.
- At least 48 hours notice needs to be given to the organizers for a game to be cancelled. If space is available during the season, the cancelled games will be made up, but this is not guaranteed, and the team canceling the game will lose the games points.
- An official decision to postpone the afternoons touch games, because of poor weather, will be made by 12:00pm that afternoon.

Rules and Disciplinary Procedures

- A central timer will be used to start and finish the games.
- Only molded boots with a minimum of 10 studs, tackies or hockey shoes will be allowed.
- Points scoring as follows: Win = 4 points, Draw = 2 points, Loss = 1 point.
- The top 4 teams in each division will contest in the finals.
- In 2 Touch reserves the right of admission, and will expel any individual who does not abide by its rules or conditions.
